

Inventor knows how to deliver

A WILLIAMSTOWN man has come up with a solution to the parcel delivery woes of the increasing number of online shoppers.

Former automotive engineer Neil Silke has designed and engineered a home letterbox he says will also safely and securely receive large parcels.

The Deliver-Eze parcel letterbox was a finalist in The Australian Innovation Awards last year and was named a favourite new product after last month's HIA Melbourne Home Show.

Mr Silke said the number of parcel packages received was increasing by between 10 and 15 per cent annually – thanks to the popularity of online shopping.

“What every home needs is a parcel box,” he said.

He said the parcel box would remove the hassle of chasing up deliveries at the post office or the risk of leaving parcels on the doorstep.

“The secret is a simple (patented) mechanism, which is a flap at the back linked to the front door.”
